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Since the turn of the 18th to the 19th century the Catholic Church and Catholic educational institutions underwent a deep change in Europe triggered by the expanding process of secularization in the emerging modern society. In consequence, the traditional physiognomy of the Catholic Church as *Mater, Domina et Magistra* was altered fundamentally. The adaptation and inner reform of Catholicism in Europe, however, remained persistently ambivalent regarding some of the key questions for modern education. The symposium aims to answer to several phenomena of catholic pedagogical renovation through focusing on secondary and higher educational structures in Europe since the 18th century to the present day. Comparing Spain and Italy, experts from both countries will deal with national and transnational actors and discourses including the Society of Jesus.

This Symposium is the second one of the *International Research Meetings* (2015–2017) "Education and Catholic Church from Historical Perspective: Tradition, Transition and Innovation in Modern and Contemporary History".

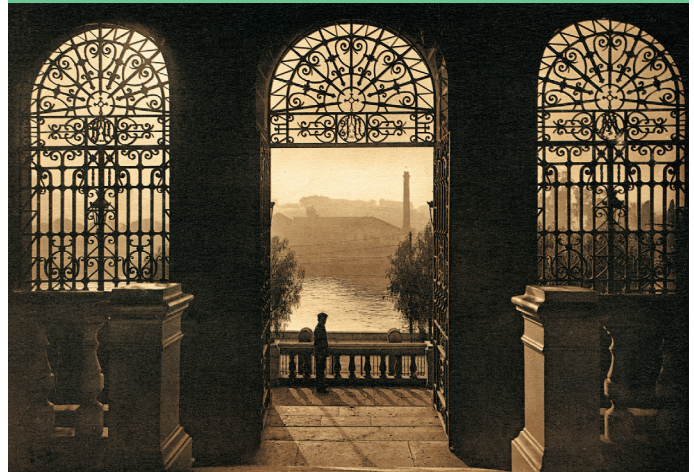


Fig.: Blessed Father Francisco de Gárate Aranguren (1857–1929) at the main entrance University of Deusto, around 1900 (private collection)
